TOH Vice-Bargaining Unit President (Vice-BUP) Job Description

The TOH Vice-BUP role is selected from TOH bargaining unit members of Local 83 and is subject to the electoral process as set out in the Local's Election Guidelines.

The TOH Vice-BUP responsibilities include the following:

- Health and Safety Chair for the local 83 Health and Safety Campus Leads (Site VPs), as well as the ONA Health & Safety representatives who sit on the campus specific JHSC. Ensures that health and safety information from ONA and any other verified sources is distributed to the H&S reps and Campus Leads as needed.
- Chairs the W5 committee to discuss accommodation issues with the hospital as per the Local Collective Agreement.
- Professional Responsibility Lead- this will include follow-up contact with members who
 have submitted Professional Responsibility Report Forms (PRRF) for workload/patient
 safety issues. Initiate development of the ONA action plan when required and tabulate
 those PRRFs to identify trends occurring on the unit. Responsible for notifying the Cochairs of the CJHAC of unresolved PRRFs that are to be presented at the CJHAC
 meeting. Keeping the affected Site VP and the TOH- BUP informed of any meetings
 and their outcome with members regarding the PRRF. A summary report of the PRRFs
 will be provided at each executive meeting.
- Act as the TOH-BUP delegate when required.
- Attends the Nursing Professional Practice Committee as a Local 83 delegate, the CJHAC and any other meetings as determined by the TOH-BUP.
- Attends the nursing orientation for new hires to explain ONA's role and sign up new hires as ONA members.
